## LIPS receives praise for academic excellence

Providing quality education for Lihir's young multicultural generation has been the core priority of Lihir International Primary School (LIPS) since its establishment in 1998.

Essentially, the school reflects Newcrest's vision to be the **Miner of choice™** by providing employees and the broader Lihir community with a top of the class learning institution that focuses on developing their children into socially responsible and respectful youths

The school currently has 90 students, from kindergarten to

eighth grade who study under the Australian primary school curriculum. This means LIPS students can easily fit into high schools in Australia (as well as in PNG) when they finish Grade 8. In aligning with Newcrest core values of **Caring about people, High performance, Honesty and Integrity, Working together** and **Innovation and problem solving**, LIPS has built strong relationships with the local Lihirian schools and schools in Australia, particularly in Queensland (QLD).

PNG's Acting High Commissioner in Australia Sakias Tameo, in his recent visit to QLD's Department of Education International (DEi), recognised and applauded LIPS for efficiently delivering quality education in PNG.

"From teachers' professional development to building relationships with stakeholders, I commend LIPS on its achievements and great work in providing quality education to the young and diverse generation which Papua New Guineans are part of," said Tameo.

LIPS Principal Gregory Neville said LIPS students are educated under the Australian curriculum through a licensing agreement with DEi. He added that the school is audited each year to ensure the high expectations of the licensing agreement are met. Furthermore, the audit ensures that teachers have annual professional development opportunities to improve teaching and learning. It also helps them to keep up with education levels delivered in QLD primary schools.

"By connecting globally, our students and teachers enjoy an enriched cultural, social and educational experience and are prepared to engage in the world," said Neville.

DEi's primary role is to lead, facilitate and coordinate the department's international activities. It develops and promotes programs for international students who want to study at QLD state schools and provides opportunities for students, teachers and school leaders to undertake educational and cultural immersion experiences and professional development internationally. ■
